D221 Alignment Goals

- Align clubs in Good Standing into a new District
 - Maintain geographic boundaries
 - Keep physical distances (Google Map estimates) to a minimum
 - Maintain Area and Division Operations
 - Contests, Training opportunities, other
 - Minimize impact on Club Operations
 - Club visits, TLI, other

D221 Alignment Guidelines

- Initial listing of clubs from Region 6, dated 31 December 2025
 - Districts 18 and 38
- Framework
 - Nine Divisions
 - Five Areas per Division
 - Five-Six Clubs per Area
 - Geographically compact as practical
- Tools Employed
 - AI – ChatGPT, Co-Pilot, X-Link, other
 - ‘Fine Tuning’ by hand

D221 Proposal

- Nine Divisions
 - A through H plus J
 - “I” intentionally skipped to avoid potential confusion w/”1”, lowercase “i”
- Five Areas per Division
 - Exception: Division B contains only four Areas
- Five to Six Clubs per Area
 - Geographically compact as practical
 - Allows for growth, modification, management
